MAY 21, 2013

Mayor Loughmiller called the meeting to order 5:37 p.m. after determining a quorum was present.

12-204A Mayor Loughmiller called for a Public Hearing to Consider/Discuss on the Request by Fourth Avenue Investments, L.L.C., on Behalf of John W. & Rebecca L. Bayless and Honey Creek Partners L.P., on a Petition to Annex Fewer than 2 Acres, Located on the North Side of Country Club Road and Approximately 600 Feet East of Nature Place. Director of Planning Michael Quint stated that the applicants are requesting to annex approximately 1.44 acres and that prior to annexing property into the City of McKinney, City staff evaluates a number of things: population of land to be annexed, the ability for the City to provide future services, and the fiscal impact to the City. He stated that Staff has evaluated all these factors and have no concern or issues at this time. Per state law, prior to annexing property into the City of McKinney, three public hearings are required. This is the first public hearing. The second public hearing will be held at the Regular meeting today at 6:00 p.m. The final public hearing will be held on June 18, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.
