

CITY COUNCIL EMERGENCY MEETING
MARCH 27, 2020

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas met for an Emergency Meeting in the City Hall Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas, on Friday, March 27, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

The emergency meeting is called seeking to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in accordance with Governor Abbott's Executive Order No. GA-08 of March 19, 2020; in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act and subject to the suspension of certain requirements of said Act as requested by the Office of the Attorney General and approved by Governor Abbott on or about March 16, 2020.

Mayor George C. Fuller called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. upon determining a quorum of the Council was present, consisting of himself and the following members: La'Shadiion Shemwell District 1

There were two (2) members of the public in attendance. Mayor Fuller called for Public Comments, at which time there were no requests to speak to the Council.

Mayor Fuller called for the Emergency Agenda Item:

- 20-0265** Consider/Discuss/Act on an Ordinance Ratifying, Continuing and Renewing the Third Revised Mayoral Declaration of a Local State of Disaster Due to a Public Health Emergency in Response to the COVID-19 Virus Outbreak, Pursuant to the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, Chapter 418, Texas Government Code; Providing a Penalty; Providing for the Publication of the Caption of this Ordinance; and Providing for an Effective Date

Council unanimously approved the motion by Council Member Charlie Philips, seconded by Council Member Rick Franklin, to approve an Ordinance Ratifying, Continuing and Renewing the Third Revised Mayoral Declaration of a Local State of Disaster Due to a Public Health Emergency in Response to the COVID-19 Virus Outbreak, Pursuant to the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, Chapter 418, Texas Government Code; Providing a Penalty; Providing for the Publication of the Caption of this Ordinance; and Providing for an Effective Date. The Ordinance will expire at 11:59 p.m. on April 3, 2020. Ordinance caption reads as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, RATIFYING, CONTINUING AND RENEWING THE THIRD REVISED MAYORAL DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 VIRUS OUTBREAK, PURSUANT TO THE TEXAS DISASTER ACT OF 1975, CHAPTER 418, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
