CITY COUNCIL JOINT MEETING

DECEMBER 7, 2010

The City Council and the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of McKinney, Texas met in joint session in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on December 7, 2010 at 4:00 p.m.

Council Present: Mayor Brian Loughmiller, Mayor Pro-Tem Pete Huff, Council members: David Brooks, Travis Ussery, Geralyn Kever, Don Day, and Ray Ricchi.

Planning and Zoning Commission Present: Chairman Robbie Clark, Larry Thompson, George Bush, Ray Eckenrode, Sean Lingenfelter, Jack Radke, and Darrell Tate.

Mayor Loughmiller called the City Council meeting to order at 4:06 p.m. after determining a quorum present.

Chairman Clark called the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting to order at 4:06 p.m. after determining a quorum present.

09-136M2 Mayor Loughmiller and Chairman Clark called for a Public Hearing for Consideration/Discussion/Action on the Request by the City of McKinney, for Approval of the Request to Amend Multiple Sections of the Subdivision and Zoning Regulations (Chapters 142 and 146 of the Code of Ordinances), and Accompanying Ordinance. Senior Planner Michael Quint stated that the City Council requested at their work session on November 29th for Staff to come back with three separate options for site plan approval, clarification on who can sign plats, and to modify the allowed building heights in the MC, BN, BG, CO1, BC, and O zoning districts. Staff is proposing to increase the building height in each of the zoning districts by ten feet with the exception of the O zoning district where it was increased to a maximum of 70 feet if there are no residential adjacency. If there is residential adjacency, the maximum building height would remain at 50 feet. Staff is proposing three options for site plan approval. Mayor Loughmiller called for public comment and there was Planning and Zoning Commission unanimously approved the none. motion by Commissioner Lingenfelter, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, to recommend approval of the Ordinance amending multiple sections of the Subdivision and Zoning Regulations (Chapters 142 and 146 of the Code of Ordinances) with Staff Recommendations and Site Plan Option 2: All site plans over 1 acre in size within 200 feet of a platted single family residential development would be approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission. All other site plan applications become Staff approval items while site plans that require variances will still go to the Planning and Zoning Commission for approval. Council unanimously approved the motion by Council member Travis Ussery, seconded by Council member Pete Huff, to approve the Ordinance amending multiple sections of the Subdivision and Zoning Regulations (Chapters 142 and 146 of the Code of Ordinances), with staff recommendations and Site Plan Approval Option 2: All site plans over 1 acre in size within 200 feet of a platted single family residential development would be approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission. All other site plan applications become Staff approval items while site plans that require variances will still go to the Planning and Zoning Commission for approval. Caption reads as follows:

Commissioners unanimously approved the motion by Commissioner Thompson, seconded by Commissioner Radke, to adjourn. Chairman Clark adjourned the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting at 4:30 p.m.
